Selection of tender process for the conduct of tenders for medicinal products of the Programme for the Procurements, Services and Medicinal Products for Health $(\Pi,\Pi Y,\Phi,Y)$ of the Ministry of Health.

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH

Having considered: The provisions:

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For the implementation of approved Programmes for the procurement of Medicinal Products of preceding years which have not yet been concluded and their duration has extended, as well as of those included in the approved Programme for the Procurements, Services and Medicinal Products for Health $(\Pi.\Pi Y.\Phi.Y.)$ for 2013 and those that will follow in the years to come and due to the fact that the inability of suppliers (the only lowest bidders) to perform their contractual obligations in whole has been repeatedly discovered, thus the normal procurement flow of medicinal products to the country's Hospitals is at risk, The Health Procurements Committee (E. II.Y) is authorised, as the Central Awarding Authority (and the other Welfare Agencies set out in article 9, par. 1 of Law 3580/07 under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Health and Social Solidarity) to conduct, hereafter, uniform open international Dutch auctions with a framework agreement with three suppliers-lowest bidders, with the use of an electronic auction, for the procurement of medicinal products with pre-described requested quantities. Ε.Π.Υ. will award the procurement of medicinal products as follows: fifty per cent (50%) for the first lowest bidder, thirty per cent (30%) for the second lowest bidder and twenty per cent (20%) for the third lowest bidder, provided that the bid of the second lowest bidder does not exceed one point five per cent (1.5%) of the bid of the first lowest bidder and respectively the bid of the third lowest bidder does not exceed the same percentage of the bid of the second lowest bidder. In case two suppliers participate in the tender, Ε.Π.Υ. will award a percentage of seventy five per cent (75%) of the procurement to the first lowest bidder and the remaining to the second, provided that the bid of the second bidder does not exceed three per cent (3%) of the bid of the first lowest bidder. The template tender notice for this tender procedure will be posted at the relevant website of the Health Procurements Committee. Tenders that are already in progress upon the publication hereof, are completed in accordance with the provisions of the respective tender notices.

This Decision must be published in the Government Gazette.
