2. the provisions of Article 49 of Law 3370/2005 (Government Gazette 176/A/11.7.2005) "Organisation and operation of public health services and other provisions", and the provisions of Articles 51 paras 2 and 3 and Article 63 para 5 of Law 3918/2011 (Government Gazette 31/A/2.3.2011) re: "Structural reforms in the health system and other provisions";

3. the provisions of Article 90 of Presidential Decree 63/2005 (Government Gazette 98/A/22.4.2005) consolidating the legislation on government and governmental agencies;

4. Presidential Decree 95/2000 "Organisation of the Ministry of Health and Welfare" (Government Gazette 76/A/2000), as amended and currently in force;

5. Document No. 8306/1.2.2012, whereby EOF forwarded to us the list prepared by the special committee of Article 12 para 1(c) of Law 3816/2010;

6. the fact that this Decision shall entail no expenditure under the government budget;

We decide

to approve a list of medicinal products sold by prescription only and not reimbursed by social security organisations as follows:

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The above list shall be reviewed and updated at least once a year by the Ad Hoc Committee mandated to compile a list of prescription-only pharmaceuticals.

This decision shall enter into force as of its publication in the Government Gazette. We order that this decision be published in the Government Gazette.
