We decide

to approve the following list of medicinal products which can be sold without prescription (over-the-counter) and which are exclusively available from pharmacies:

The above list may be amended following an application by marketing authorisation holders or a reclassification by EOF.

Earlier lists of over-the-counter pharmaceuticals (see accompanying document 7,8) shall cease to be valid as of the publication hereof.

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Government Gazette.
