Subject: Withholding of amounts in favour of the MTPY on the costs of EOPPY for the procurement of medicines and pharmaceutical materials

Dear Mr. Perratis,

We have recently been informed that your Fund submitted a query to the supervising Ministry, i.e. the Ministry of Labour and Social Insurance, regarding the legality of the 3% withholding in favour of the MTPY on the costs of EOPYY for the procurement of pharmaceutical materials and that the Ministry of Labour replied that the said withholding has no grounds on the applicable legislation and is therefore illegal.

Given that pharmaceutical companies are arbitrarily subjected to the said withholding for more than a year now, thus sustaining the relevant loss and since there are no legal grounds, we believe that it is absolutely necessary in the context of proper Management, that the MTPY immediately restores legality by means of proceeding with all necessary actions.

It is noted that some companies have already resorted to legal remedies and in order to avoid the unnecessary discomfort for all parties involved, we kindly request that you send to EOPYY and to all parties involved, including SFEE, a document with which it will be made clear that based on the applicable legislation, the 3% withholding does not apply for the costs of EOPYY for the procurement of pharmaceutical materials.
